

Beauty Point Public School

Fencing works notification | 8 August 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We wish to advise that we will be replacing the existing fence and installing new fencing in some sections along the north boundary between neighbouring properties and Beauty Point Public School.

The NSW Department of Education can fence off school properties as indicated in the [Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 \(ILP Act\)](#). Beauty Point Public School is 'inclosed land' for the purposes of the ILP Act.

By securing the gates and restricting access, we will be providing greater safety and security for our students, staff and the wider community.

The NSW Department of Education will cover the cost of the work. You will not be required to make any financial contribution.

The scope of work involves:

- removing the existing mesh fence and replacing with new open tubular black steel security fence with a spear top along the north boundary
- a section of the fence along the boundary north of Building J will be new and sit 2 metres back from the boundary fence for maintenance access
- electronic access gate will be installed at the front of the school along Pursell Avenue
- permanent closed-circuit TV (CCTV) camera will be installed above one new Electronic Access Controlled (EAC) pedestrian gates on Pursell Avenue. The purpose of these cameras is to monitor entry into the school premises and add a level of security for students and staff.
