Works notification | 15 December 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Damage in the form of a crack was recently found at an internal wall in Building A at New Lambton Heights Infant School.

The damage occurred on Tuesday 2 December 2025. As the wall lining is known to contain asbestos, access to this room was immediately restricted and an independent hygienist was engaged to undertake testing and provide advice.

Testing confirmed that the asbestos is bonded.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Repair of the wall by sealing the crack took place on Saturday 13 December 2025 between the hours of 7 am to 8 am.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures including air monitoring were in place while works were done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists before the room is reopened for use.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
