Works notification | 16 October 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

On Friday 6 October 2023, fragments of suspected asbestos containing material were found on the ground near the covered walkway between Buildings A and B at Cardiff North Public School. As a precaution, the area was cordoned off.

Testing was conducted by an independent hygienist and the material is confirmed to be bonded asbestos, which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

The area will be remediated as soon as licensed and accredited contractors can be scheduled. It will remain out of bounds until remediation is finished.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
