Dear staff, parents and carers,

Following a proactive inspection, we are replacing roof materials on the north side of Building C (a general classroom block) at Cardiff North Public School.

This work will involve removing asbestos-containing material from an external eave sheet, recently identified as bonded asbestos on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work to replace the eave sheet is planned to take place on Saturday 26 July 2025.

Safety measures will be in place during the work including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist before clearance is provided to allow ongoing access.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
