

Glenvale School

Project update

September 2022

Project overview

A program of maintenance work to improve the facilities for students at Glenvale School and provide the best learning environment at the North Entrance Campus is underway. These works are being delivered in stages to ensure disruptions to students and staff are minimised. Works include:

- Upgrade of stormwater system and completion of playground remediation work
- Refurbishment of the four teaching spaces in Block G
- Refurbishment of the Cottage, being used as a learning space for practicable life skills learning
- Construction of a covered walkway between Block G and the nearby toilet block

Progress update

The project team is meeting with the school principal on a regular basis to keep the school up to date on the progress of the work.

Stormwater upgrade and playground remediation

The department has engaged a hydraulic engineer to complete a preliminary design to improve stormwater management at the school. This important work will significantly improve the amenity and usability of spaces across the school. The proposed work will include regrading some areas on the site to improve drainage and installation of additional stormwater pits and lines. New concrete swale drains will also be installed as part of this work.

We are liaising with Central Coast Council to clear existing blockages in its stormwater system before work can begin.

Once the stormwater upgrade has been completed, the final stages of the playground remediation works will be undertaken including the installation of an AS1428 compliant ramp and path for access to the area.

Block G refurbishment

The Department is finalising the draft scope of works for the refurbishments in Block G. The work will include:

- Upgrade to the entry doors and thresholds to each classroom
- Additional kitchenette joinery
- Removal of existing sliding doors between the classrooms
- Upgrade to existing electrical and data services
- Pin boarding to internal classroom walls
- Preparation and Painting

The works are scheduled to happen during the December and January school holiday period.

Cottage refurbishment

The refurbishment works to the Cottage will include:

- A new entry
- Removal of internal walls to create a large open area
- New floor coverings
- A new kitchen
- Internal painting

External works will include a new deck and the recladding of the entire building. Works are scheduled to start in Term 4, 2022.

Covered Walkway

Work is scheduled to take place in the upcoming school holidays between Saturday 24 September and Sunday 9 October 2022 to provide all weather protection for students and staff.

The work will also include the addition of translucent roof sheeting to the adjacent outdoor activities area to improve natural light to the area.
