

# Glenvale School North Entrance Campus

## Works notification | 23 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

On Wednesday 22 March, during routine inspections at Glenvale School North Entrance Campus, cement sheeting that may contain asbestos was found outside a shed behind building D.

As an added precaution, the area where the sheeting was found has been fenced off to keep students, staff and school visitors separate until the material can be tested. We are following all the advice and protocols of independent asbestos hygienists and other experts.

Testing by an independent hygienist will occur sometime between Thursday 23 March and Wednesday 29 March 2023 to confirm the nature of the material and if remediation is needed.

If the material is confirmed to be asbestos, this area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited independent asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

If remediation is necessary, the area will be inspected to ensure any asbestos has been fully remediated and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is re-opened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
