## Project update | February 2023

### Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's COVID-19 Recovery Plan, \$120 million has been committed to accelerate projects and deliver modern infrastructure to schools right across regional NSW. An additional \$120 million is available for schools in metropolitan Sydney to deliver a range of projects that will help improve the amenity of their school.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

### Project overview

A project is underway at Sir Eric Woodward Memorial School to build a new school hall which will include sports courts, facilities for assemblies and performances, and amenities.

The new hall will accommodate a variety of learning, recreational and communal activities. The project also includes the construction of new covered pedestrian paths to connect the existing buildings to the new hall.

#### Progress summary

Since the last update distributed in November 2022 we have finished:

- external cladding
- putting in remaining window frames
- putting in glass to windows
- tiling to wet areas
- painting
- putting in services.

The project is expected to be completed by the end of February 2023. The programmed activities for the upcoming month of February 2023 are:

- start putting in sports floor
- start waterproofing to wet areas

- putting in synthetic turf
- putting in stormwater pits
- putting in fencing
- putting in soft landscaping.
