

Sir Eric Woodward Memorial School

Works notification | 18 March 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

On Thursday 13 March 2025 a damaged eave lining of Building A, outside the distance education staffroom and near the playground area, was identified by staff at Sir Eric Woodward Memorial School.

The eave linings of Building A are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

The area was immediately made inaccessible to students and staff and the damaged eave lining was taped up.

An independent hygienist has been engaged to remediate the area.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours on Saturday 29 March. Air monitoring will be in place and the independent hygienist will issue a clearance certificate when the work is completed.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
