Dear staff, parents and carers,

Planning is underway to install 2 new demountable classrooms at Ajuga School.

The new classrooms will provide 2 additional teaching spaces — one will also include toilet and laundry facilities.

Installation will begin with delivery of the buildings onto the school site via Roy Watts Road from 8 to 11 October (Spring School Holidays).

A mobile crane will lift the buildings from trucks onto brick footings.

The demountables will be connected to water, electrical, data and sewerage systems during Term 4.

Work is expected to be complete by 1 November.

We will ensure works are carried out safely and efficiently to minimise impacts to the community.
