Works notification | 5 June 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Wednesday 3 June 2026, we inspected the demountable classroom at North Gosford Learning Centre in response to a complaint about water damage.

During our inspection we discovered mould in a cupboard shelving. The cupboard was immediately locked and access restricted. The cupboard will be removed on Saturday 6 June 2026.

The affected cupboard is attached to a wall which contains undisturbed bonded asbestos material, as listed in the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work to remove the cupboard will be done under the guidance of an independent hygienist to ensure the asbestos remains undisturbed. Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place, and the hygienist will issue clearance once the work is finished.

All asbestos-related work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.
