

# Arncliffe Public School

## Works notification | 29 October 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We are refurbishing the student toilets in Building F at Arncliffe Public School.

The refurbishment project will include:

- new bathroom fittings
- new lighting
- improved ventilation
- repainting of surfaces
- new tiling of the floors and walls.

To prepare for this work we are removing wall sheeting assumed to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the school's asbestos management plan.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Asbestos removal work is planned for Saturday 29 and Sunday 30 November 2025.

Safety measures including fencing, air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment will be in place during this work. All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

Alternative toilets will be made available at the school during the toilet refurbishment project, which is expected to be finished by the end of December 2025.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
