School holiday works notification | April 2023

School Infrastructure NSW regularly inspects and maintains school infrastructure as part of a comprehensive and ongoing program to keep school assets in optimal condition and ensure the safety and wellbeing of our school community across more than 2,200 NSW schools.

The school holidays are the ideal time for some maintenance projects as it means work can take place without disrupting learning.

Planned maintenance over the holidays may involve working with hazardous materials such as asbestos or lead containing material. This is to notify you of this work.

Planned maintenance

As previously advised, before the beginning of Term 1 2023, precautionary work was successfully undertaken to address lead containing material within Block C at Gardeners Road Public School. This included applying a new coat of paint to all walls (up to two metres in height), and to all other paintable surfaces in the building.

We will be conducting further preventative maintenance in Block A and Block C **during the April school holidays between Friday 7 April and Sunday 23 April**. The work will include applying a new coat of paint to worn surfaces, including doors and skirting boards.

The areas will be cordoned off before work begins and will remain out of bounds to anyone visiting the school site until the work is finished.

All work will be undertaken by a licensed and accredited contractor and monitored closely by an independent occupational hygienist. A clearance certificate will be provided to the school by the independent occupational hygienist before the areas are reopened for next term.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
