Project update

October 2022

A maintenance program to improve student facilities at Hamilton Public School is underway. These works will be carried out on Block B and include repainting the outside of the building, replacing windows and installing a new lift.

Progress update and remediation works

Work will start on Wednesday 26 October 2022, and is expected to take approximately five months to complete.

The work will involve working with lead-containing material located in the existing paint of the building. All hazardous material works will be done outside of school and Out of School Hours Care (OOSHC) hours with spaces made safe for occupation for school days.

The area will be cordoned off before works start, and additional safety measures and monitoring will be put in place. It will remain out of bounds to students and staff until the removal and associated maintenance work are completed.

This lead-containing material will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community are our highest priority.
