Dear staff, parents and carers,

Further to the works notification outlined below, we would like to update you regarding the installation of the platform lift in Building A at Hamilton Public School.

The start date for this work has been rescheduled to mid-March 2026.

Because some buildings at Hamilton Public School have significant heritage value, we needed extra time for design and planning reviews. This included completing a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) to ensure all approvals were in place. As a result, the contract award was delayed, and the works have been rescheduled to allow time for this approval process, which is required by statutory planning regulations.

The installation is expected to be completed by Term 3, 2026.

Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We are installing a platform lift in Building A at Hamilton Public School.

This project will start during the summer holidays from Monday 5 January 2025. Work will continue through terms 1 and 2 and is expected to be finished by Day 1 Term 3 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.

Access to Building A will have an alternative path during construction. Entry will be via Gate 2 located on Dixon Street. Please follow the direction of signs to the building.

The Out of School Hours (OOSH) and vacation care service which runs from Building B will not be affected and will operate as usual during the holidays.

By installing a lift in our school building we will enhance the accessibility for people in our school community and visitors with mobility challenges.

Work hours

Work will take place between 7 am and 6 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
