We would like to provide update on our project to install a platform lift in Building A at Hamilton Public School.

During the upcoming autumn holiday period, we will be changing the pedestrian entry point near Building A on Dixon Street as outlined in the diagram below. This temporary access point on the western side of Dixon Street will remain place until the works are finished.



Due to delays with procurement, this project is now expected to be finished during Term 4 2026.

Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We are installing a platform lift in Building A at Hamilton Public School.

This project will start during the summer holidays from Monday 5 January 2025. Work will continue through terms 1 and 2 and is expected to be finished by Day 1 Term 3 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.

Access to Building A will have an alternative path during construction. Entry will be via Gate 2 located on Dixon Street. Please follow the direction of signs to the building.

The Out of School Hours (OOSH) and vacation care service which runs from Building B will not be affected and will operate as usual during the holidays.

By installing a lift in our school building we will enhance the accessibility for people in our school community and visitors with mobility challenges.

Work hours

Work will take place between 7 am and 6 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
