

# Kurri Kurri Public School

## Works notification | 15 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

A project is underway to refurbish the classrooms in Building E at Kurri Kurri Public School.

The ceiling void in this building is known to contain lead dust. Lead is considered a low health risk provided it isn't inhaled or ingested.

Termite damage has been identified in this area and the lead will need to be removed to enable works to continue.

Work to remove lead dust from the ceiling will take place over 2 consecutive weekends – Saturday 23 to Sunday 24 May and Saturday 30 to Sunday 31 May 2026 with safety measures in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and completed by experienced contractors.

The classroom of Building E will be inspected by an independent hygienist and a clearance certificate will be issued before the refurbishment works continue.
