The heritage stonework restoration on Building A at Rozelle Public School is now complete. The project, which began in June 2024, is finished and all areas are now open for use.

Building A is a much loved and distinctive feature of the Rozelle community. It was designed by architect John Horbury Hunt and constructed from sandstone in 1877.

restored stone facade, including
cleaning and repointing



restored gables and chimneys



roof plumbing upgrades



a new tiered seating area with 2
adjoining stairways and an outdoor
learning area



repaired brickwork and stonework



restored and repainted timber
elements

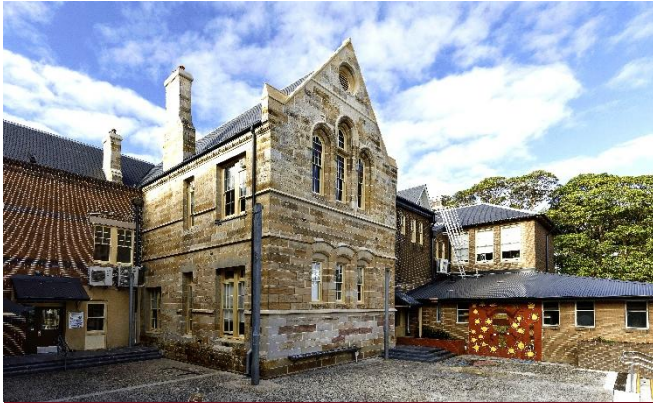

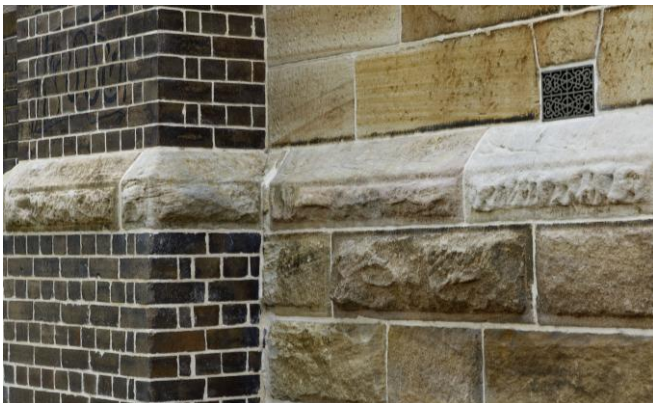

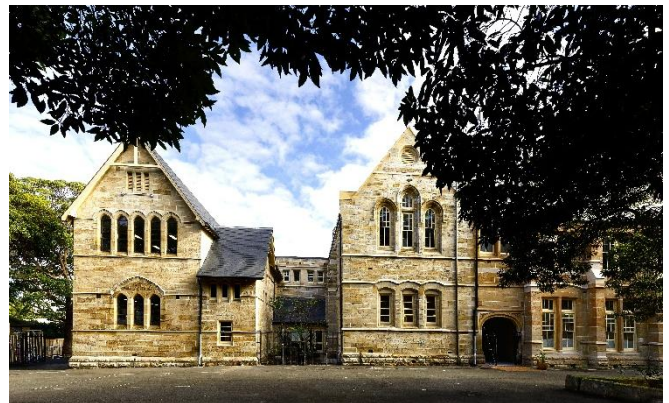
