

# Rozelle Public School

## Works notification | 1 September 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are removing a section of redundant pipe recently identified during the heritage stone restoration and masonry work being conducted on Building A at Rozelle Public School.

As outlined in the works notification issued on 20 August 2025, the pipe has remained encapsulated and secured following the discovery of bonded asbestos material.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Air monitoring returned results below the minimum detectable limit. This means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. < 0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines. These results show that there is no detectable level of asbestos fibres in the air in this area.

The affected section of the pipe will be removed on **Sunday 14 September 2025**. There will be no disruption to school operations or the Rozelle Collectors Market.

This building is isolated within a construction zone and inaccessible by students and staff. The pipe is located on the outside of the building on the second floor.

Removal will be undertaken by licensed asbestos contractors under the supervision of an independent hygienist, and in strict accordance with all work health and safety requirements and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Once removal is complete the independent hygienist will inspect the area and issue a clearance certificate.

The health, safety and wellbeing of our students, staff and local community remain our highest priorities.
