Dear staff, parents and carers and neighbours,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are pleased to inform you we are replacing the carpet in the home base rooms in Block 6 at Rosehill Public School.

As part of this work, we will be removing vinyl tiles assumed to contain bonded asbestos and not identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

Work to remove the vinyl tiles will take place on Friday 19 June 2026 and will be completed on the same day. All work involving asbestos-containing material will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as air monitoring and PPE in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
