

# Woy Woy Public School

## Works notification | 17 September 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During a recent inspection, we identified wall material requiring repairs in the standalone storeroom near the play equipment (Building I) at Woy Woy Public School.

The wall was suspected to contain asbestos and was immediately isolated.

An independent hygienist was engaged on Wednesday 10 September 2025 to conduct testing and install air monitoring.

The hygienist confirmed the wall material contained bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

We are removing the asbestos on Saturday 20 September 2025. The storeroom will remain isolated until the works are finished, and clearance certificate issued.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Safety measures include air monitoring and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
