Works notification | 27 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During yesterday's heavy storm conditions, an eave sheet was dislodged from a demountable building at Woy Woy Public School.

No one at the school was injured during the weather event. The external area around the eave sheet of the demountable building, which is used as a classroom and listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan, was immediately cordoned off. Temporary fencing has been installed to isolate the area.

Sample testing and air monitoring will be conducted by an independent hygienist. Once remediation works are completed in coming days and clearance is provided by the hygienist, the area will be reopened, and usual school activities will resume.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and will be inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. We will keep the community updated.
