Albury High School Works notification | 13 February 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we will be replacing carpet in the Building C dark room at Albury High School from Saturday 22 February to Sunday 23 February 2025.

We will also remove vinyl tiles beneath the carpet as part of this work.

These tiles are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed in the school's asbestos register.

Access to the room will be restricted and safety signage will be installed at the end of the school day on Friday 21 February.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures will be in place while work is being done.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The room will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated and a clearance certificate will be issued before it is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
