Gosford High School School holiday works notification – Autumn | 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the Autumn School Holidays and Term 2

We will be working at your school during the Autumn School Holidays from 14 April 2025 through to late Term 2 2025.

As part of planned maintenance, we will be refurbishing the existing student changerooms in Building B (a science and general classroom block) at Gosford High School.

This refurbishment will include repainting, retiling, and replacing partitions, toilets and basins. To prepare for this work, we will be removing shower partitions and window putty material in the changerooms known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

Work involving asbestos-containing materials is expected to be completed within the holiday period. During this work there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
