

Hurlstone Agricultural High School

Works notification | 9 September 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the upgrade of the Hurlstone Agricultural High School boarding facilities and farm hub is now finished and operational.

Remediation works

During site inspections of the farm area, asbestos containing material was found in the ground behind the new Piggery.

The material has been confirmed as bonded asbestos which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

As a precaution, the area has been cordoned off to keep students, staff and school visitors separate.

Work to remove asbestos containing materials will take place on Friday 12 September from 7am.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws, and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plansite-specific Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is reopened.
