Future of Maitland Grossmann High School

The department is dedicated to providing a vibrant and productive learning environment at Maitland Grossmann High School.

This year, we have carried out extensive refurbishments to ensure every student feels supported, valued, and has access to quality facilities.

Looking ahead, we are carefully exploring options for the school's future, including the potential of relocation and for expansion of the school.

The health, safety and wellbeing of students, staff and the broader school community remain the department's highest priority.

Planning for the future of Maitland Grossmann High School has involved reviewing enrolment projections for the area, considering the needs of the broader school community and a review of the current school assets.

With relocation identified as an option, we are exploring potential sites in the Maitland Local Government Area (LGA) as part of this planning work.

We will provide an update on the preferred option in 2026.

School improvement works

Improvement works at the school are continuing. We are pleased to share the following progress:

- The VET hospitality kitchen is finished and now being used by students and staff.
- Block C and D painting work is finished.
- The contract for the covered walkways, shade structures and the timber wall replacement between Block F and M has been awarded, and work will start over the summer holidays.
- The tender applications for the improvement work to the appearance of Block E are currently under review. We expect work to start over the summer school holidays.

When will a decision be made?

We expect to have selected a preferred option in 2026.

If a relocation is determined as the best option, when would this occur?

If it is determined that a relocation is the best option for the school, the timing will depend on when land is secured, and the timeframe for planning applications and construction is determined. We will provide an update on the preferred option in 2026.

What facilities would be delivered?

The department has site selection guidelines that assist in determining the facilities and space required for schools. As part of our planning, we look at how the community's population is expected to grow to the capacity schools need in the long term. This helps us make sure schools meet the needs of students now and in the future.
