

Maitland Grossmann High School

Works notification | 25 September 2025

Work is underway to improve the operations and amenities at Maitland Grossmann High School. This work is being undertaken while we explore options for the school facilities into the future.

Block E temporary fence damage

On Tuesday 23 September 2025, there was a second break-in at Maitland Grossmann High School and a section of the temporary fence isolating Block E was damaged.

The damage was found during school hours on Wednesday 24 September 2025. Block E is separated by fencing and hoarding and was, and remains, inaccessible to staff and students. Work to assess the area and repair the fence was organised immediately.

Air monitoring results were checked by an independent asbestos hygienist who has confirmed the break-in did not change the air quality within the building.

Improved security measures

When school finished that afternoon, we installed a solid core door to improve security to the building. A solid core door is made with a thick, heavy centre using special wood or materials. It is tougher and provides more security than a hollow core door.

Health and safety measures

All air monitoring to date across the site has returned results below the minimum detectable limit, which means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. <0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines.

These results represent a consistent finding that there is not a detectable level of asbestos fibres in the air in this area. Asbestos fibres pose a risk to health if airborne. In this case the evidence and advice from our hygienist is that there is not airborne asbestos in this area.

All work is done in accordance with work, health and safety laws, and the site-specific Asbestos Management Plan. All work is completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.
