Works notification | 12 February 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Work to upgrade the student toilet facilities in buildings CA and A at Tamworth High School will begin during Term 1.

Toilet upgrade work

- floor and wall tile replacement
- painting and lighting upgrades
- replacing cubicles (toilet partition walls)
- installing water-saving cisterns.

This work starts on Thursday 13 February 2025 and is expected to be completed in July 2025.

Alternate toilet facilities are available across the school site during this time.

Asbestos removal

As part of these upgrades, we will be removing asbestos-containing ceiling linings in the toilets outside school hours on Tuesday 18 February.

Access will be restricted while asbestos removal is carried out.

NSW Health explains that living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures will be in place while work is being done.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The toilets will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated and a clearance certificate will be issued before upgrade work continues

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
