

Tamworth High School

Works notification | 2 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We have continued the toilet upgrade works in buildings CA and A at Tamworth High School which began in [February 2025](#).

As part of this work an independent hygienist completed testing of the ceiling linings in the boys and girls toilets in Building CA.

Test results confirmed the presence of bonded asbestos which will be removed on Tuesday 13 May and Wednesday 14 May 2025.

Access will be restricted while asbestos removal is carried out and air monitoring will be in place.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The toilets will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the toilets are reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
