

# Yanco Agricultural High School

## Works notification | 4 March 2026

Dear parents, staff and carers,

As part of the [fire rebuild](#) for the Building L laundry facility at Yanco Agricultural High School, we are preparing Building O to be used as a temporary laundry.

During a recent site inspection on Wednesday 25 February 2026 where contractors scoped a temporary laundry fit out, they identified damaged floor tiles known to contain bonded asbestos sheeting in Building O. This area is listed on the School's Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

As a safety precaution, the building was immediately isolated and locked to students and staff.

Asbestos removal works are scheduled to take place on Thursday 5 March 2026 until Saturday 7 March 2026 while students and staff are on their designated leave (DESI). Work hours will be between 6 am and 8 pm. An independent hygienist will be on site on Sunday 8 March 2026 to inspect and provide certificate of clearance.

The works will include:

- removal of 12 square metres of damaged floor tiles
- removal of 40 square metres of asbestos sheeting under the veranda
- seal exposed surfaces with PVA glue after removal.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures, including temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment, will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who will provide clearance certificates.

### **Planned work over the upcoming holidays**

Following completion of the asbestos removal and confirmation of clearance, works will continue at Yanco Agricultural High School to undertake the temporary fit-out of laundry facilities in Building O.

These works are scheduled to occur during the Autumn School Holidays and extend into early Term 2, 2026. Please note that these dates are indicative and may be subject to change.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
