Works notification | 29 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We will begin 2 refurbishment projects at Casino High School on Monday 1 June 2026.

Staffroom refurbishments

We will be refurbishing 5 staffrooms across Buildings A and C at Casino High School.

This work will include:

- replacement of carpet throughout the staffrooms
- replacement of shelving units
- installation of new desks
- repainting of all plasterboard walls.

Work in each of the rooms will be scheduled to allow staff to relocate to other areas while the refurbishment is completed.

Resources and equipment will be removed on Monday 2 June 2026 and contractors will begin work in the staff rooms on Monday 8 June 2026.

It is expected the refurbishment works will be completed by mid-July 2026 and the rooms will be operational from Day 1 Term 3 2026.

The refurbished staffrooms will provide an enhanced workspace and more comfortable workspace for staff.

Kitchen refurbishment

We will also be installing a new kitchenette in the National Aboriginal Sports Chance Academy (NASCA) room, with work beginning on Monday 1 June 2026.

The kitchenette will include cabinetry, benchtops, a microwave, sink and tapware, upgraded water supply and electrical services.

Removal and demolition will begin on 1 June, before plumbers and electricians install the new appliances on Tuesday 2 June and Wednesday 3 June 2026.

It is expected the NASCA kitchenette will be operational from Thursday 4 June 2026.
