Works notification | 6 February 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During the Summer School Holidays, we replaced a damaged window in the staffroom in Building 1A and the library in Building L at Casino High School.

The work involved disturbing the window frames suspected to contain bonded asbestos.

Before work started we engaged an independent hygienist to test the material. The results came back positive for bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

The window frames were removed and replaced with non-hazardous material.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

When the work was completed, the independent hygienist issued a clearance certificate.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
