Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We're pleased to let you know about upcoming improvements to the fencing at Willoughby Girls High School. From early March 2026, we'll be upgrading our boundary fencing and installing a new access gate to better manage entries and exits through our school grounds.

What's happening

The scope of work involves:

- installing a new access gate at the end of Medway Lane
- re-fencing a small portion of the fence on Mowbray Road
- installing a new fence along Keary Street to enclose the oval, improving safety while creating a secure, inclusive space where all students can confidently learn and play

We expect the work to be finished by the end of Term 2, 2026, site conditions and weather permitting. The NSW Department of Education will cover the cost of the work.
