

# Wyong High School

Works notification | 9 October 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are replacing damaged windows in a classroom, staffroom, and interview room in Building C at Wyong High School. This work will involve working with known asbestos containing material in the window frames.

The windows have been covered in plastic sheeting and because the window frames are undisturbed the rooms remain in use.

The windows will be repaired on Saturday 28 October 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before works start.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The rooms will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the rooms are reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
