## Works notification | 18 February 2026

Dear parents, staff and carers,

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, a project is underway to deliver a new multipurpose building for the growing community in Quirindi High School.

### Upcoming site establishment works

Following site establishment works will start on Wednesday 11 March 2026 will involve setting up temporary fencing and mesh hoarding.

### Start of construction

Following site establishment, major construction works on the new multipurpose building at the high school will begin. The following key construction activities are expected from Monday 11 March 2026:

- frequent delivery of construction materials
- earthworks, piling, excavation and structural works, in preparation for concrete pours
- the installation of cables, pipes, tanks and other essential services.

There will be increased construction activity on Abbott Street, Station Street and Nowland Street during these works. Traffic control will be in place as required to manage vehicle movements around the site, and noise and vibration impacts are expected during these activities.

### Working hours

Standard construction works will take place from Monday to Friday from 7 am to 6 pm and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised.
