Works notification | 20 October 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are replacing two windows in the Science Building at Kurri Kurri High School. The windows will be replaced in the science lab and prep room. This work will involve working with asbestos containing material in the putty along the window frame.

Both the lab and prep room are being safely used at present as the window frame is undisturbed and it will be cordoned off before the work starts.

Work to remove and replace the window and frame will take place Saturday, 4th November. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The lab and prep room will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before either room is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
