

Kurri Kurri High School

Works notification | 25 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are relocating shade structures in the central quadrangle at Kurri Kurri High School.

The shade structures will be moved from where they are now on the Deakin Street side to the existing concrete pads in the quadrangle. The relocation involves removing the Jacaranda tree, however ample shade will remain.

The area is listed in the school asbestos management plan as having in-ground asbestos, so safety measures will be in place while work is underway from mid-December 2025 to late January 2026.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Works will take place outside of school hours when there are no students onsite. An independent hygienist has been engaged to oversee the project and provide advice.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who will provide clearance before the area is reopened for use.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
