Following the fire last year, demolition work was completed in October 2024 before construction of the new building began in December 2024. An electrical upgrade was commissioned as well as the reconnection of essential services such as gas, water and data.

This project has delivered:

- a new wet area
- new split system air conditioning
- A new walkway and access path.

The new building has been constructed to Education Facilities Standards and Guidelines, ensuring it supports proven teaching methods while providing a learning space that meets the individual needs of Junee High School.
