Works notification | 10 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of our scheduled maintenance at Corrimal High School, we will be replacing the ceiling lights in Building I on Tuesday 10 February 2026.

The ceiling lining is known to contain bonded asbestos as per the Schools Asbestos Management Plan.

As a precaution, the building will be locked and out of bounds to students and staff during the work.

All work involving asbestos-containing material will take place outside of school hours.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The ceiling linings will be inspected by the independent hygienist and a clearance certificate will be issued before the light replacement work continues.

The building will be open and available for use from Wednesday 11 February 2026.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
