Works notification | 15 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Following damages to the boys toilet in Building B at Wellington High School, suspected asbestos containing material was found in the ceiling. As a precaution, the area has been cordoned off and is out of bounds.

Testing will be conducted by an independent hygienist to confirm the nature of the material and if remediation is needed.

If necessary, this area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited independent asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the toilets are re-opened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
