Works notification | 27 August 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Monday 18 August 2025, from 7 am to 5 pm, repair work was completed to damaged fibro eave sheets in the first-floor hallways and stairwells of Building C, at Wellington High School. The sheets are known to contain bonded (non-friable) asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health advises that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged."

The affected area was temporarily fenced off and isolated until works were completed.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done.

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists. The area was reopened after a clearance certificate was issued. The health, safety and wellbeing of our students, staff and school community remain our highest priority.
