Works notification | 5 April 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During a routine inspection on 20 March 2024, following a storm event at Singleton High School, a staff member uncovered mould growing on carpet behind a cupboard in the demountable building (Girls' Academy) staff space.

The room was immediately cordoned off and a hygienist engaged for testing and remediation advice.

Remediation was scheduled for the following day to environmentally clean the spaces and remove any impacted materials in affected areas after school hours. Any water leaks that contributed to moisture build up will also be repaired.

All work involving hazardous materials took place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and air monitoring in place while work was being done.

All inspections and remediation works were conducted in accordance with recommendations from the independent hygienist.

Use and access to the areas were restricted until a clearance certificate was received and the space reopened for use.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
