Works notification | 30 April 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During heavy rainfall on 6 – 7 April 2024, a seminar room in Building B at Dapto High School was damaged.

On 8 April 2024, as a precautionary measure, the room was locked and made inaccessible to students and staff.

Work to remediate this room will involve working with asbestos containing material in the vinyl floor tiles from the area as listed on the school's asbestos register.

The asbestos is bonded to other material such as vinyl or concrete and cannot be crumbled under light pressure.

Work to remove and replace the flooring will be done out of school hours on Saturday 4 May and Sunday 5 May 2024, with additional safety measures and air monitoring put in place before the work starts.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The room will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the room is reopened for regular operations.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
