

# Normanhurst Boys High School

## Works notification | 9 September 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

After repairs and precautionary measures were taken today, **Normanhurst Boys High School will reopen tomorrow, Wednesday 10 September.**

This follows the school being non-operational for one day due to a small fire on a solar panel on the roof of one of the buildings.

We took these immediate actions:

- Electricians were onsite shortly after the fire was identified on Monday 8 September and again today, Tuesday 9 September from 6 am, monitoring the roof.
- A special type of lift was brought in to enable access to the roof area and roof cavity.
- An electrician has isolated the part of the solar panel where the fire started – the part that converts sunlight into energy.
- All solar panels at the school were inspected and disconnected as a further precaution while we consider options to improve future solar panel component access.
- While there was no structural damage to the roof, tarpaulins were laid as rain is forecast for tomorrow.

Electricians have cleared the school to reopen. School operations, including the HSC Music examinations, resume tomorrow.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We greatly appreciate that students and staff engaged in remote learning today. Thank you for your understanding.
