## Project update | April 2024

### Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

### Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade the hall at Picton High School. The project includes refurbishments to the walls and lighting, new toilet and change room facilities, as well as upgrades to the stage, storage and air conditioning.

### Progress summary

We are pleased to announce Barbro Constructions (NSW) Pty Ltd has been appointed as the builder to complete the remaining construction of the Picton High School hall upgrade.

### Next steps

With the new builder on board, a detailed works program will be finalised, and they will begin to reestablish the site in the coming weeks and prepare to restart construction.

Remaining works to finish the multipurpose hall are expected to be complete by Day 1 Term 3, subject to weather conditions. An exact date for completion and handover will be shared with the community once the builder has finalised the works program.
