Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The NSW Government has committed funding for a project to install walls in open-plan classrooms at Picton High School. This upgrade will provide enclosed classrooms, ensuring that students and teachers have suitable environments for teaching and learning.

Stage 2 involves separating larger spaces into individual learning spaces, installing walls in open learning spaces to create enclosed classrooms and converting smaller spaces into new staffrooms.

Progress summary

Work on the interior has continued with walls and doors installed to create 5 classrooms. This work involved enclosing 2 classrooms and a practical activity area, as well as separating a larger learning space into 2 separate classrooms.

Additionally, defects on the hall have been rectified.

These spaces were handed back to the school earlier this term.

Next steps

As these works are finished, we will continue to return the spaces to the school for their use.

We're pleased to share that we are on track to have Stage 2 finished by the end of Term 4 2025.
