Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

Project overview

The NSW Government has committed funding for a project to install walls in open-plan classrooms at Picton High School. This upgrade will provide enclosed classrooms, ensuring that students and teachers have suitable environments for teaching and learning.

Progress summary

We are currently in the process of evaluating tender submissions for Stage 2. The main works contractor is expected to be selected shortly.

Next steps

- Once appointed, the contractor will finalise the designs for construction purposes.
- Construction is expected to begin in late 2025.
