Project overview

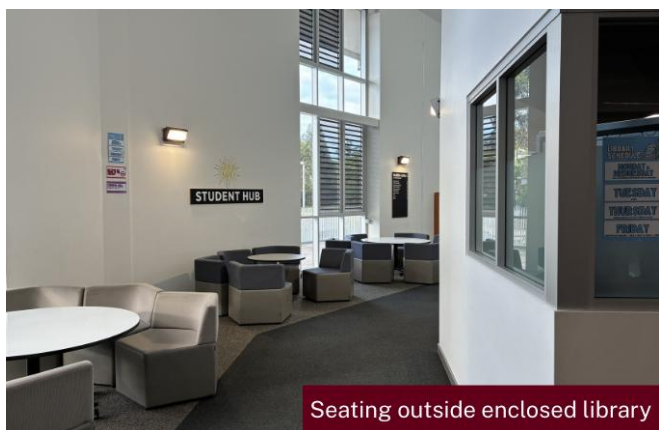
The NSW Government committed funding for a project to install walls in open-plan classrooms at Picton High School. This upgrade enclosed classrooms, ensuring that students and teachers have suitable environments for teaching and learning.

Works involved separating larger spaces into individual learning spaces, installing walls in open learning spaces to create enclosed classrooms and converting smaller spaces into new staffrooms.

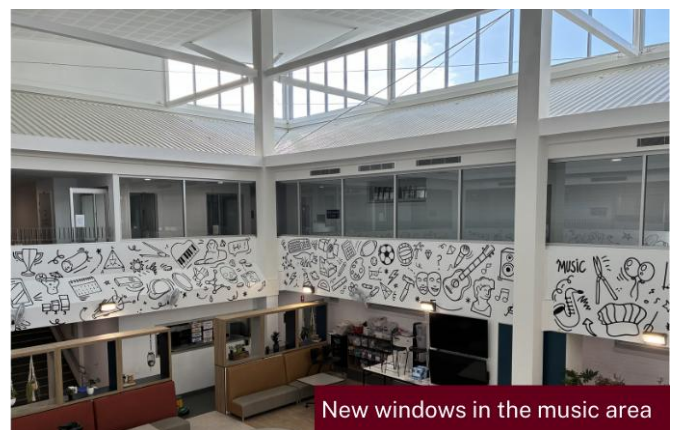
Progress summary

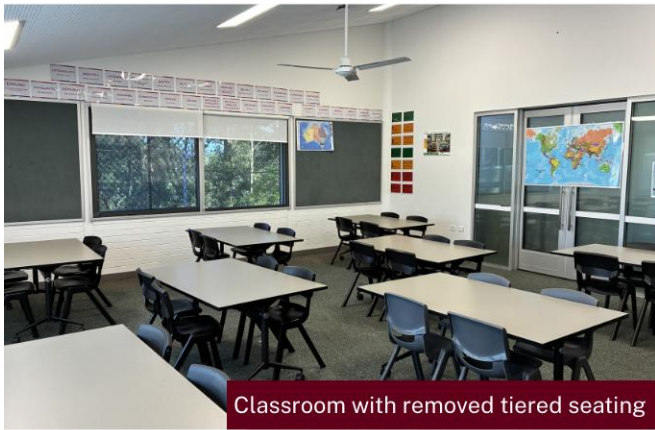

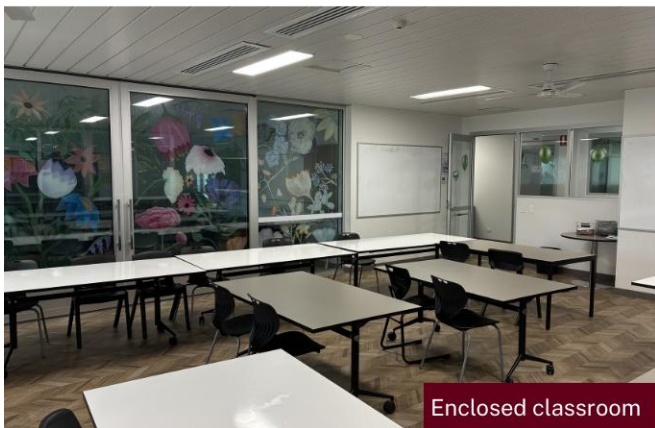
