Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The NSW Government has committed funding for a project to install walls in open-plan classrooms at Picton High School. This upgrade will provide enclosed classrooms, ensuring that students and teachers have suitable environments for teaching and learning.

Stage 2 involves separating larger spaces into individual learning spaces, installing walls in open learning spaces to create enclosed classrooms and converting smaller spaces into new staffrooms.

Progress summary

Work on the school's interior is progressing with new walls and doors installed in 5 learning spaces. These spaces will be handed over to the school for their use this month.



Next steps

- As works are completed, we will continue to hand back the spaces to the school for their use.
- Continue working with the contractor and school to ensure minimal disruptions to school operations and HSC exams during the works.
- All Stage 2 works will be completed for the beginning of Term 1 2026.
