The NSW Government has committed funding for a project to install walls in open classrooms at Picton High School. This upgrade will provide enclosed learning spaces, ensuring that students and teachers have suitable environments for teaching and learning.

Construction works starting

We are excited to announce that the construction contract for Stage 2 has been awarded to Secure Building Solutions and work has begun.

Stage 2 involves separating larger spaces, combining smaller ones, and turning general learning areas into new staffrooms.

The works include:

- building new solid and glass partitions to create enclosed classrooms and staffrooms
- updating ceilings and flooring, and repainting affected areas
- adjusting mechanical, electrical and data systems to suit the new layout.

We will work closely with the contractor and school to minimise impacts on the school community during this work including avoiding noisy works during exams and important events.

Working hours

All works will take place between 7 am - 5 pm, Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
