

Picton High School upgrade

Works notification | 6 December 2024

The NSW Government has committed funding for a project to install walls in open classrooms at Picton High School. This upgrade will provide enclosed learning spaces, ensuring that students and teachers have suitable environments for teaching and learning.

Construction works commencing

Construction works to enclose the first set of open classrooms are scheduled to start on Monday 9 December 2024 and will continue throughout the school holidays. These Stage 1 works are expected to be completed in time for the start of Term 1 2025.

The works will include:

- removing sections of 3 classrooms
- installing new wall framing and lining
- modifications to the air conditioning systems and upgrades to power and data services.

Temporary fencing will be installed to secure the work area. Construction vehicles will access the site via Argyle Street, Picton, and traffic control measures will be implemented as required to ensure safety and minimise disruption.

Working hours

All works will take place between 7 am and 5 pm, Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

School Infrastructure closure

School Infrastructure will be closed from 5 pm Friday 20 December 2024 to 9 am Monday 6 January 2025, inclusive. During this time, if there is an urgent issue, please contact the site manager listed on the construction site entry. In an emergency, please call triple zero (000).
